
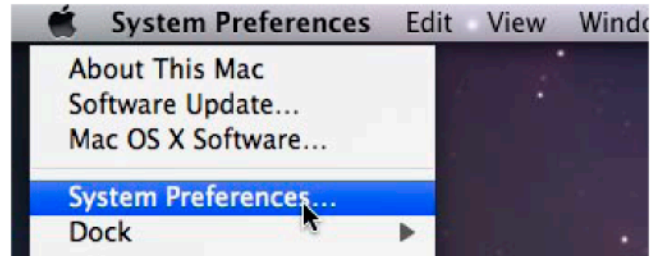


# New Color Monitor Preferences

The monitors in the photo lab have been calibrated with an X-Rite Color Munki calibrator. Since student accounts are housed on a remote server you will need to assign the calibration profile to your account each time you use one of our computers.

To do this follow these instructions.

Click on the  symbol from the top left corner of the display. Click and select System Preferences...



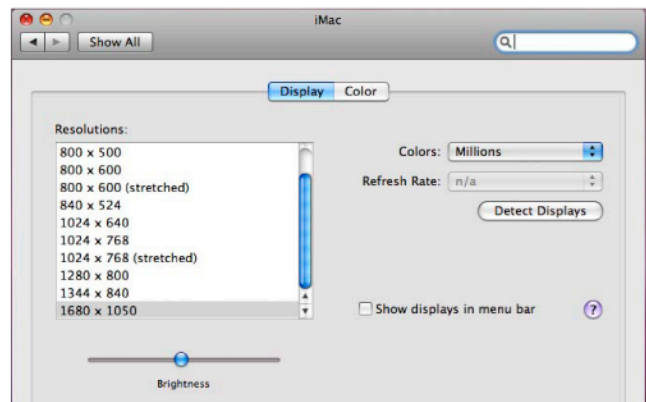
From the Preferences window select Displays by clicking once.



The brightness on each monitor has been adjusted to a 120 lumen standard. There is no way to lock this down.

**Pease do not change the brightness level.**

From this window click on the Color tab.



Select the monitor profile from the list. All of the computers are marked with a letter. The letter precedes the naming nomenclature for example iMac\_A\_D65\_4-28-11.

You will need to do this for each computer you use in our lab.

If you don't see our nomenclature, unclick the box to show more choices and pick the correct profile from the list.
